4. <u>Presentation: SD78 Student Leadership Conference – ShineOn!</u>

Teachers Lenora Poulin and Erin Wilkins reported on SD78's Student Leadership Conference that was organized by Hope Secondary Leadership students and held at the Hope & District Recreation Centre on May 2, 2017. One hundred and twenty seven people attended the day-long event which included both adults and students (mixture of leadership and non-leadership). The key-note speaker was Ian Tyson followed by student lead workshops.

5. Fraser Valley Student Leadership Forum (video)

The superintendent shared a video from the student forum that was held in the fall and asked the breakout groups the following question:

How can students personalize their own learning?

- Investment in time that a teacher makes with a student
- Extra-curricular activities
- Students select what they want to learn
- Communication between student & teacher

The superintendent also shared a video of Dr. Lennet Anderson that was shown at the student forum:

Key take-a-ways:

- Energy
- Words are powerful
- OK to stumble on your journey
- To delay is not to deny
- Not a period but a comma just a pause in life, not a stop
- Popularity does not validate you
- Risk-taking theme
- Teachers are transformational leaders
- Need teachers not buildings

6. <u>District Growth Plan</u>

The superintendent indicated that data will be updated once it is received. The overarching goal 'culture of inclusiveness' will continue to be a focus. Goal 3 will include numeracy and literacy assessments instead of provincial exams. We will also review reserved seats in Careers & Transitions or Accuplacer exams to show how students are making progress.

Some concerns raised were: how is data created with self-assessment; and how will the new assessments affect the post-secondary institution requirements.
