

Summer School 2021

July 5 - 30, 2021 Monday to Friday

Schedule

Students will be scheduled by summer school staff for a minimum of two (2) in-class sessions per week from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. In-class sessions will be for academic support and testing. Students who wish to attend additional in-class sessions, can do so up to a maximum of five (5) sessions per week. Students will be expected to work independently on the other days. Their teacher will be available in the mornings from 8:30 am - 10:00 am for extra help as needed.

Expectations

Regular progress is expected. With only one month to complete their assigned work, students will be expected to make the most of their in-class time and behave in a mature, business-like manner. When students have completed their assigned course(s) they will no longer be required to attend.

Parents may refer their child(ren) with the approval of summer school administration in order to ensure that space is available. Capacity limits will be determined during the last week of June. If your child is approved for summer school, a referral and consent form will need to be completed.

Programs

Students in **Grade 7-9** may be offered a compressed version of Math and/or English to prepare them for the next grade level.

IV Students wishing to complete a course not previously attempted or not yet completed may do so if space is available.
